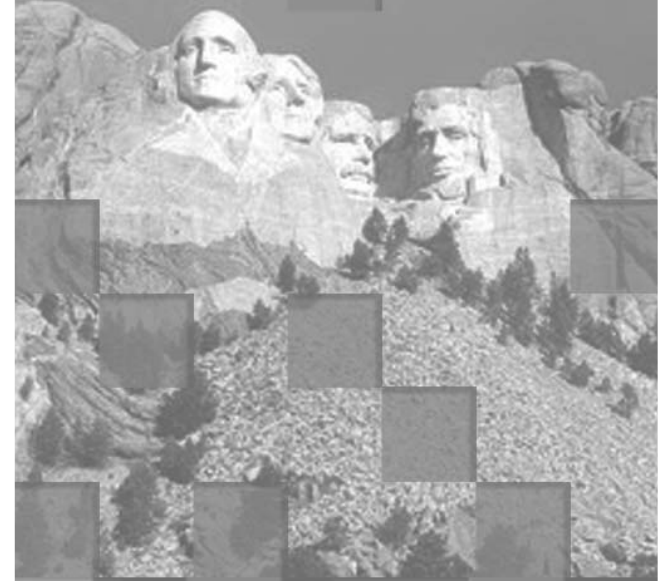

WHAT IS LEADERSHIP CAMP?

Leadership Camp is a week-long, residential camp that teaches students the fundamentals of leadership and citizenship. This camp is offered to students who are entering grades 7-9.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Working in cooperative teams, students will:

- learn the fundamentals of leadership and learning styles
- identify a problem in their community that requires a solution
- gather and evaluate information on the problem
- examine and evaluate alternative solutions
- develop a proposed policy and action plan to address the problem

Students will visit local government agencies and will also visit the Chiesman Foundation for Democracy and Mt. Rushmore on field trips. Students' work is displayed in a class portfolio the last day of camp and will be reviewed by community leaders.
