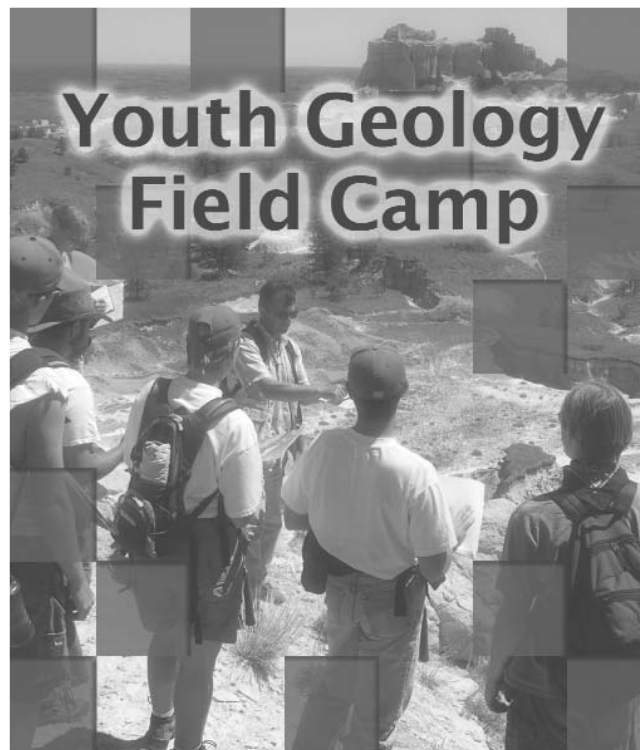

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

If you like the outdoors, then this camp is for you! Youth Geology Field Camp is an overnight, outdoor camping activity for middle school students in grades 6-8, and high school students in grades 9-12.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

How does the Earth work? Minerals, rocks, magmas, landforms, etc. will be explored during camp.

- Recognize minerals, rocks, and fossils
- Learn basic geology
- Learn to use topographic maps
- Learn to read a compass
- Understand geologic maps
- Understand water, landslides, and earthquakes
- Learn the geology of the Black Hills
- Understand the making of mountains and landforms
- Understand volcanoes and magmas
- Collect minerals, rocks, and fossils
- Live the life of a field geologist

CAMP DETAILS

Students will have same-sex roommates for tent camping, eat real outdoor cooking, visit the Museum of Geology, and go on field trips to see geologists in action at real geology camps and research labs and local industries. Campers will set up tents (supplied by the School of Mines).

Counselors are assigned to the campers in a ratio of one for every fifteen campers. Students will need to bring sleeping bags, pillows, and other personal items.

Students need experiences to help them make critical decisions about what courses to take in college. The camp features an atmosphere of discovery and guidance. Also, the camp will enhance their exposure to possible areas of college study and future professions.
